Bulk Trash Pick Up

From Friday, November 14th until Tuesday, November 18th, we will have a large dumpster in the guest parking area near the pool available for bulk items. Please be mindful of the fill limit. The collection company will not pick up the dumpster if it is beyond capacity (beyond the top of the container).

Your Back Yard is Someone Else's Front Yard



Regular garbage pick-up is every Monday and Thursday morning, and recyclables are picked up on Thursdays. All refuse must be put out INSIDE a sturdy container (to deter rodents); no garbage bags may be left out for pick-up. Containers may be left out no earlier than 5:00pm the night before service and must be brought back inside your gate and out of public view by 9:00am the day after service. Remember that what may be out of your view is in plain view of your neighbors. Receptacles left out for more than 24 hours will be collected, and residents will be able to retrieve them

near the locked shed by the pool by speaking to Luis during his normal business hours. Please keep in mind that Luis is doing his job in helping to beautify our community.

Be Safe Not Sorry

We have had a recent rash of break-ins and items stolen predominately from unlocked cars. Please be sure to keep both your car and your house doors locked at all times--even during daylight hours. It is a sad commentary on our times, but several of our community members have already fallen victim to watchful thieves. If you have sliding glass doors, as most of us do, it is highly recommended that you get a bar (e.g., wood, metal, even a broom stick) to fill the track between the inside closed door and the wall. This prevents intruders from simply "popping" the sliding door off of the track and entering--without ever breaking the glass. Above all, always be aware of your surroundings.

Be a part of the solution. We strongly urge all residents to become involved by joining us at our regularly scheduled board meetings at 7:00pm on the third Tuesday of each month. Meetings are held at the clubhouse at T.Y. Park. Notices in advance of each meeting are always posted at mailbox stations. We welcome input from our community members.
